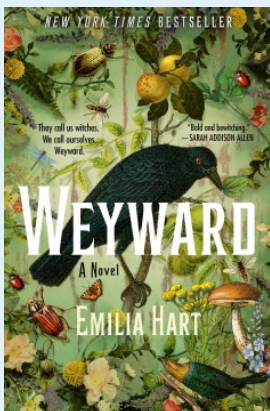

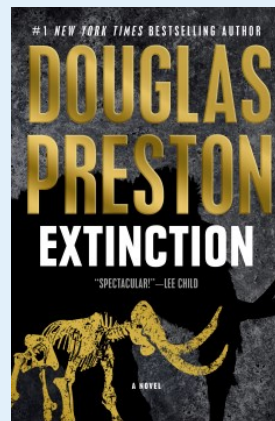

by Emilia Hart

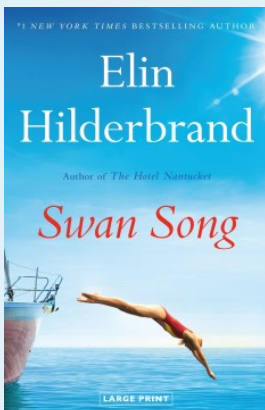

by Douglas Preston

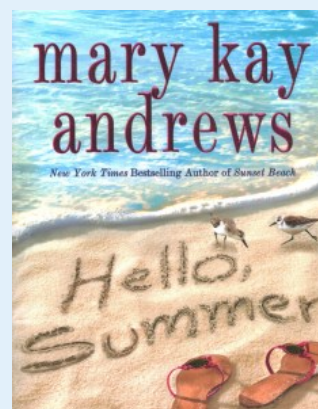
