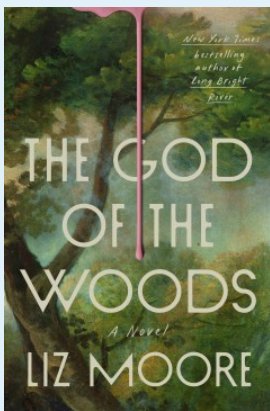

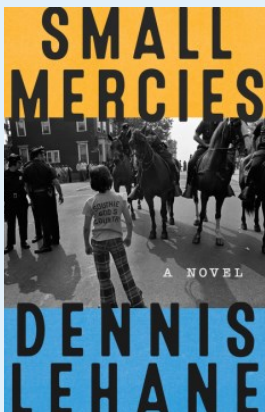

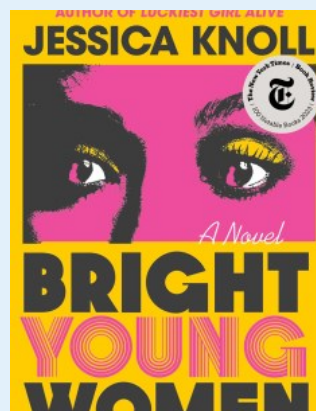
**The God of the Woods**

Set in 1974, the Boston public schools are about to be desegregated by busing. Both the Black and white (Irish) residents are on edge. And then a black boy is killed and a white girl goes missing. by Jessica Knoll  
This novel is based on the murders of two sorority sisters by Ted Bundy. This is not a Ted Bundy book - but is based on his crimes. There is not too much emphasis on the serial killer. It is mostly based on the sorority sisters, the survivors and their loved ones. And the ineptitude of law enforcement. I could not put this down.
