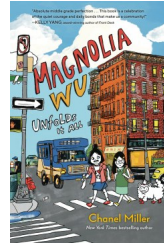


Magnolia Wu Unfolds It All by Chanel Miller

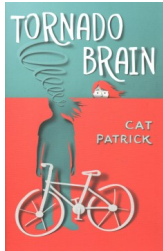

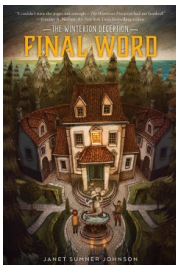

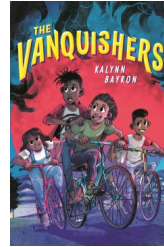

The Mystery of Locked Rooms by Lindsay Currie



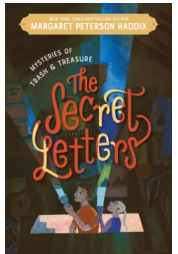

While accompanying her parents to Paris, twelve-year-old Nell sets off to investigate the disappearance of her beloved, former au pair, affectionately known as Pear.

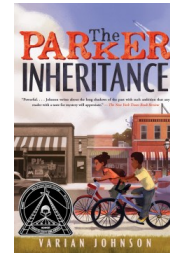
