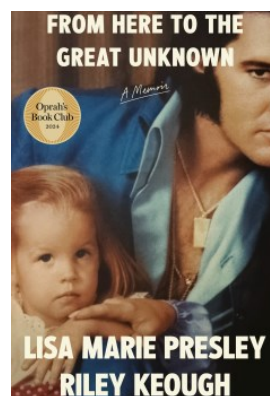
The Christmas Bookshop
