
## 1) THE WOMEN BY KRISTIN HANNAH

In 1965, a nursing student follows her brother to serve during the Vietnam War and returns to a divided America.




### 2) JAMES BY EVERETT, PERCIVAL

The second book in the Empyrean series. Violet Sorrengail's next round of training might require her to betray the man she loves.




### 7) CHRISTMAS IN BETHEL BY EVANS, RICHARD PAUL

An emergency medical technician develops a relationship with an author who is not completely honest with her.




# 8) TO DIE FOR BY BALDACCI, DAVID

The third book in the 6:20 Man series. Devine digs into the deaths of an orphan's parents and uncovers a large conspiracy.




# 9) THE MIRROR BY ROBERTS, NORA
