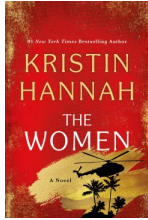

BY KRISTIN HANNAH

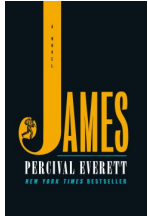
In 1965, a nursing student follows her brother to serve during the Vietnam War and returns to a divided America.

BY EVERETT, PERCIVAL

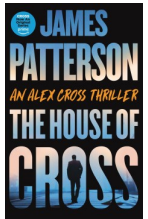
A reimagining of "Adventures of Huckleberry Finn" shines a different light on Mark Twain's classic, revealing new facets of the character of Jim.

BY BALDACCI, DAVID

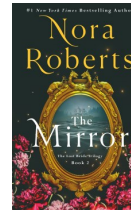
The third book in the 6:20 Man series. Devine digs into the deaths of an orphan's parents and uncovers a large conspiracy.

BY PATTERSON, JAMES

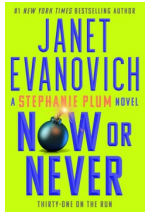
The 33rd book in the Alex Cross series. Three candidates to the Supreme Court are violently attacked.

BY ROBERTS, NORA

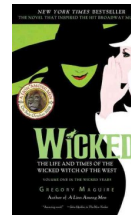
The second book in the Lost Bride series. In a haunted mansion, Sonya receives a vision of a bride murdered on her wedding day.

BY EVANOVICH, JANET

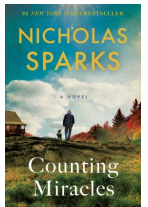
The 31st book in the Stephanie Plum series. Caught between two fiancés and not knowing what to do, Plum gets back to business as a bounty hunter.
