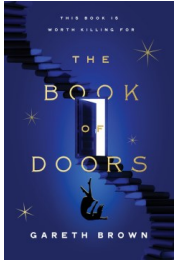

by Gareth Brown

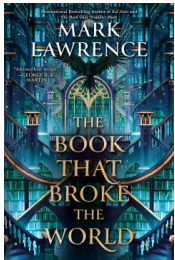

by Kelly Link

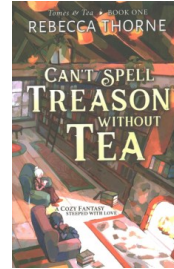

by Mark Lawrence

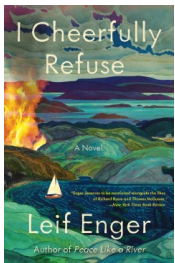

by Leif Enger

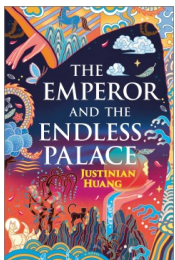

by Leigh Bardugo

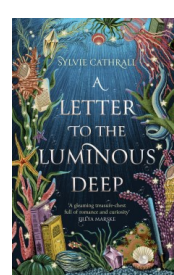

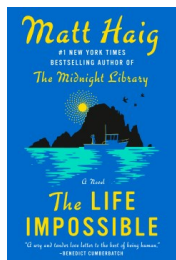


A Letter to the Luminous Deep

A beautiful discovery outside the window of her underwater home prompts the reclusive E. to begin a surprising correspondence with renowned scholar Henerey Clel.

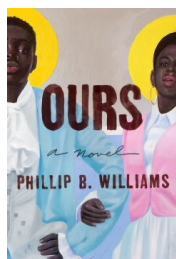

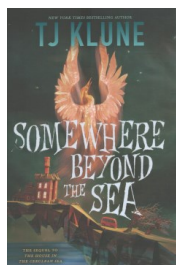

by Phillip B. Williams

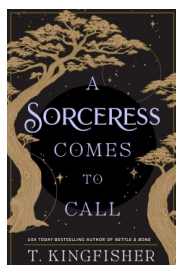

by Julie Leong

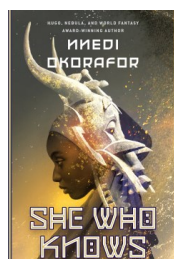
