After surviving a bus accident, veteran Joh Reiff awakens in the hospital alive and suspicious that the doctors aren't telling him something.




The Morningside








Beautyland

The Ministry of Time






Ghost Station




Echo of Worlds

An artificial intelligence believes the end of the universe is near and assembles a team to search the multiverse for the Mother Mass.




Exordia

A disaffected office worker has an unearthly close encounter and joins a team to investigate a mysterious otherworldly broadcast.




Fiasco




The Moonlight Market

After his family is brought down in a traitorous plot, Paul must go undercover to seek revenge, and to bring to fruition humankind's most ancient and unattainable dream.




Nightflyers
