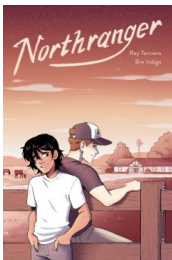


Brownstone

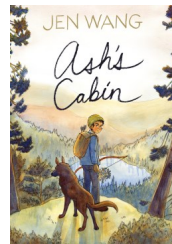


Bunt!

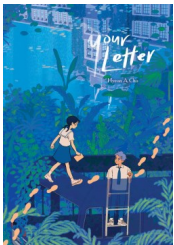


Cat on the Hero's Lap

Honjirou is an actor trying to land a breakout role. He fears his weight stands in the way of his dreams, but someone supporting his work gives him a new confidence on the stage.

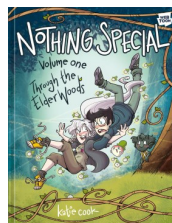


A Kingdom of Quartz
