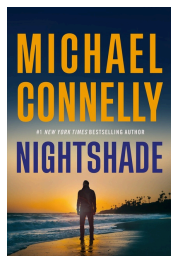

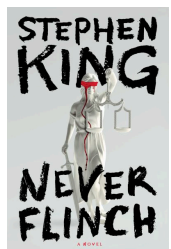
Nightshade

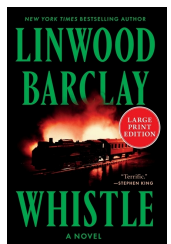
Don't let him in

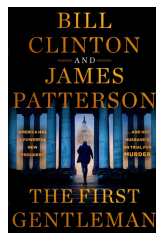
Whistle : a novel

An epic new novel set against the backdrop of the 1980s space shuttle program and the extraordinary lengths we go to live and love beyond our limits. **June 2025**



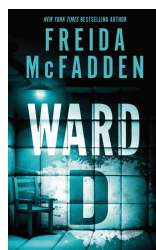
The First Gentleman

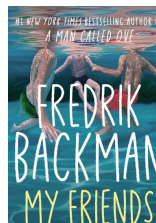

Bury Our Bones in the Midnight Soil

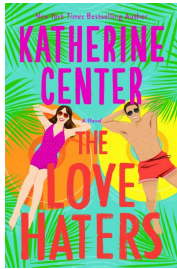
