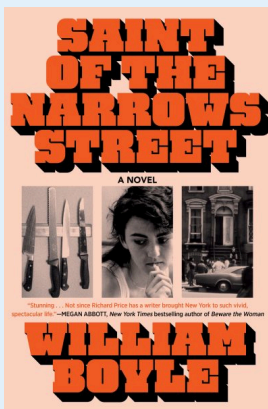

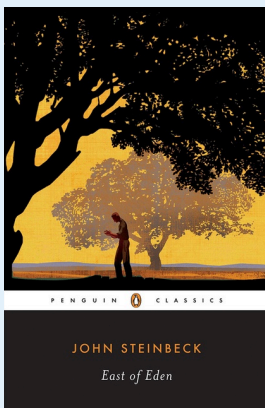

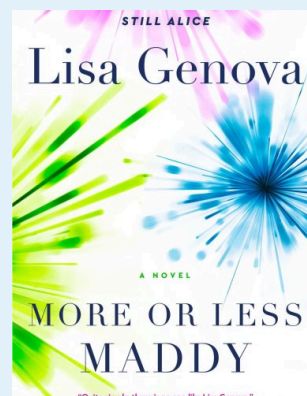
Saint of the Narrows Street
