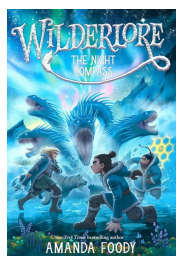

by Christina Soontornvat

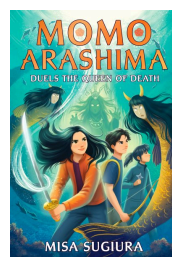
