


The Man Made of Smoke by Alex North Wow, Alex North is an amazing crime/thriller writer. A young boy comes across a serial killer and an abducted boy in a rest area bathroom. His hesitancy to help the kidnapped boy has far reaching consequences, even into adulthood. Lots of suspense here with a little spookiness thrown in.



The Women on Platform Two by Laura Anthony Set in two different timelines -1969 and 2023 - in Dublin, Ireland. All forms of contraception are illegal in Southern Ireland in 1969 (yes! 1969!), and a group of women risk everything to change that. The friendship between a doctor's wife and a butcher's wife was so heartwarming, as well as their determination to change the rules.



The Briar Club by Kate Quinn I loved this book! A group of women living in a boarding house during the Red-fearing McCarthy era, form a somewhat dysfunctional family. Each chapter is told from the POV of one of the women. Highly recommend the audio.



The Jackal's Mistress

by Chris Bohjalian This is based on the true story of a friendship between a wounded Union soldier and a Confederate wife. I loved the relationship between the wife's 12 year old niece and the soldier which provided a little comic relief. This novel does not flinch from the horrors of war, the racism, the utter destruction but it does show a human element.
