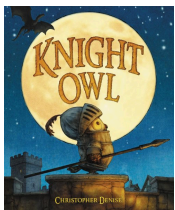
Jabari Jumps

"Looks easy," says Jabari, watching the

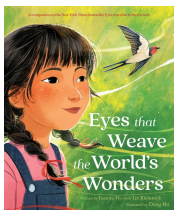

by Doug Salati

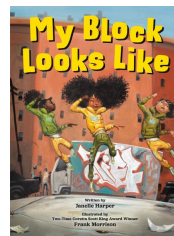

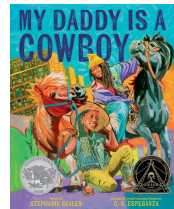


My Block Looks Like

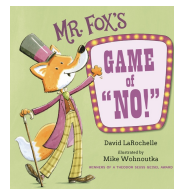

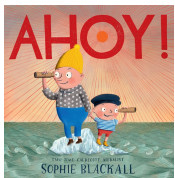


Cesaria Feels the Beat

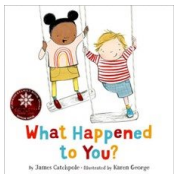


Joyful Song : A Naming Story

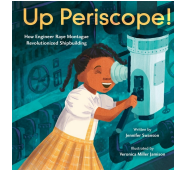


What Happened to You?

groundbreaking program that revolutionizes the way ships and submarines are built, setting her on a path to becoming the Navy's first female program manager of ships.

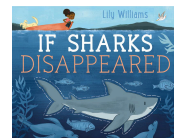


Niki Nakayama : A Chef's Tale in 13 Bites

populations, explaining how sharks are facing extinction and the important role sharks play in keeping the oceans clean.

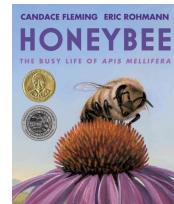


Make Way for Animals! : A World of Wildlife Crossings
