Think of it like a game—each book you read and each challenge you complete brings you one step closer to becoming a reading champion!

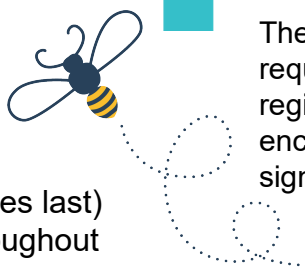
