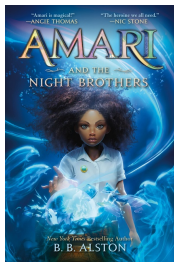

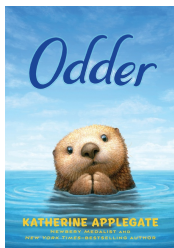

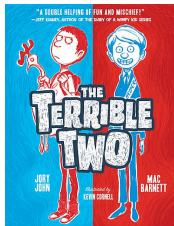


Odder

dramatic turn, one that will challenge everything she believes about herself--and about the humans who hope to save her. Simultaneous eBook.

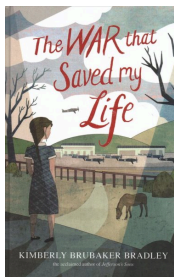


The Terrible Two

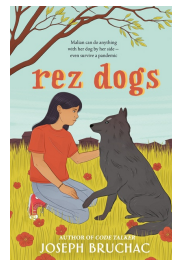


The War That Saved My Life

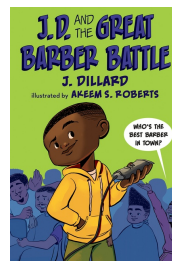

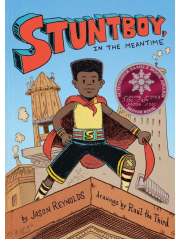


Gabby Torres Gets a Billion Followers

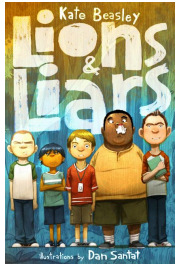

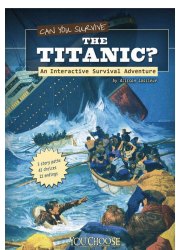


Front Desk

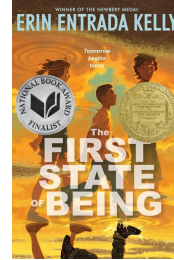

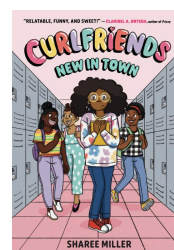

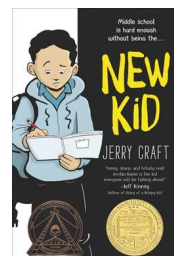
