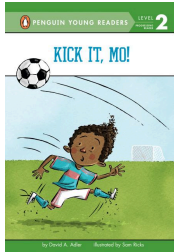

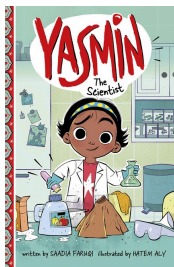

Everyone seems to have an idea for the science fair except for Yasmin, but after some failed experiments, Yasmin's snack break with Nani inspires an idea.

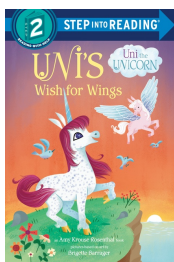


Dance! Dance! Underpants!

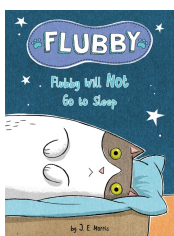
underpants to show.

by Candice F. Ransom

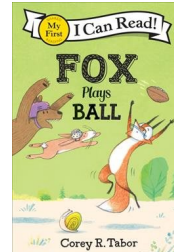

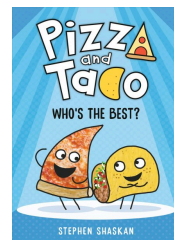

Fox and Chick are unlikely friends, but somehow they seem to get along together, even though Fox is calm and thoughtful, and Chick is hyperactive and flighty.

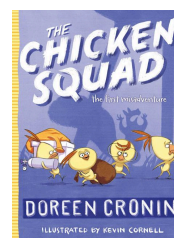


Pizza and Taco : Who's the Best?

who's the best! Can their friendship survive the race for top spot on the popularity food chain? Cast your VOTE!



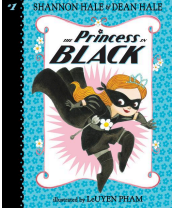
The Chicken Squad
