How Do I Participate?

- 1 Sign up with library staff and receive your free Summer Reading Club registration packages. While supplies last!
- 2 Join our **Read Around the World Beanstack Challenge** to track the number of minutes you read from Thursday, July 3 to Thursday, August 14.
- 3 Read and log at least 30 minutes per day (or 210 minutes per week!) for a chance to win amazing prizes!
- 4 Visit a branch to see our amazing prizes on display, participate in a library program or checkout a new book.



How Do I Use Beanstack?



Find instructions to sign up for Beanstack on the last page of this booklet.



Scan the QR code (or download the Beanstack app), set-up your account and enter challenges.



There are no ballots to fill out (*yessss!*), it's all tracked online for you.



If you've already created a Beanstack account, you're all set - just login and join the **Read Around the World: Summer Reading Challenge**.



Don't forget to adjust your current age to be entered into prize draws for your age group!

How Do I Win?



Join the **Read Around the World: Summer Reading Challenge** and log the number of minutes you read starting on Thursday, July 3.



Aim to read for 30 minutes per day (or 210 minutes per week!) to be eligible for weekly branch prize draws. Complete the challenge to be eligible for the ECL grand prize draw!

Visit the library each week to earn your activity badge codes.

Remember to log your weekly minutes into your Beanstack challenge by the dates below to be eligible for the weekly prize draws:

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR beanstack



- 1 Search for Beanstack Tracker where you get apps for your device or scan here →
- 2 Tap **Let's Go!** and then choose At my library, school, or bookstore
- 3 Tap **Find a Site** and search for Elgin County Library (CAN) and then choose **Sign Up!**
- 4 Provide an email address and create a password. These will be your log in details!
- 5 Enter your first and last name and if you would like, a phone number.

Tip: If you are an adult creating an account for a child, please add your details first. All members of the same family can be under the same account!

- 6 Choose a Branch from the drop-down list. Pick your local library and tap **Continue**.
- 7 Yay! You're all signed up! If you are signing up yourself, then choose **Fill Out My Reader Profile**. If you are creating an account for the children in your family and don't wish to participate in any reading challenges yourself, then Tap **Add A Reader**.

Tip: As you add reader profiles to the account, you can register each reader for challenges that they qualify for. So make sure to register for all readers!
