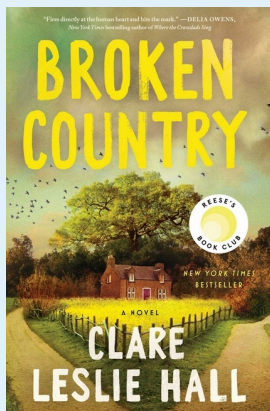

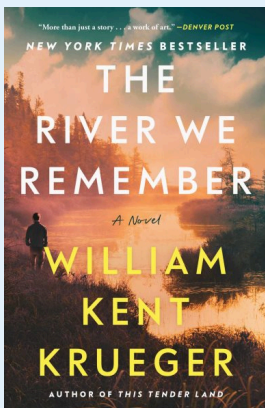

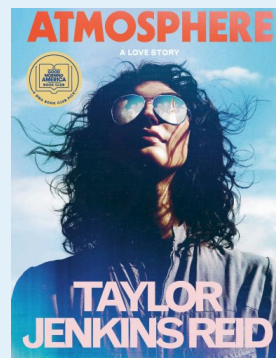
Broken Country
