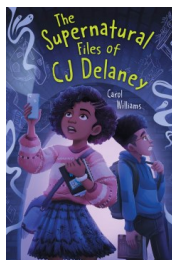


The Ghosts of Nameless Island

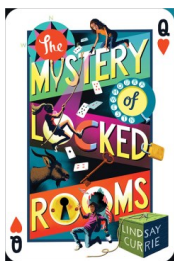


Camp Twisted Pine

With her family on the verge of losing their home, Sarah searches for a treasure inside a funhouse. When things take a dangerous turn, she refuses to turn back.

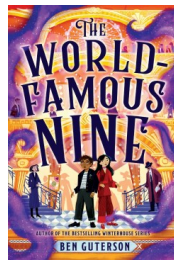


Spy Ring

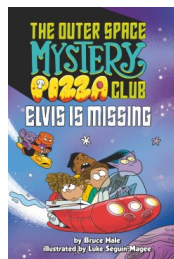


The World-Famous Nine

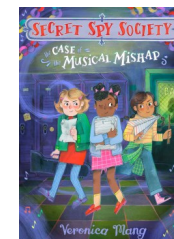


Capitol Chase

Ten-year-old twins Ike and Iris race to find the thief stealing valuable historical artifacts before their family is framed for the crimes.

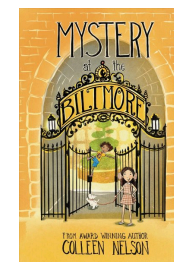


The Case of the Musical Mishap

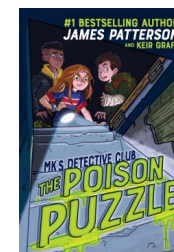


Mystery at the Biltmore: The Vanderhoff Heist
