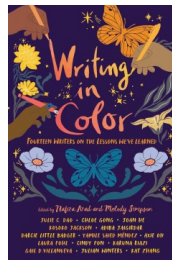

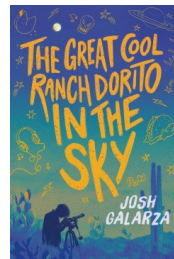


The Wilderness of Girls

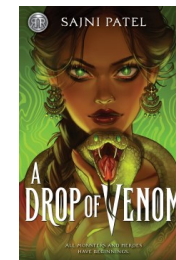


A Drop of Venom

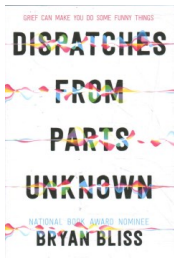


Stay With My Heart
