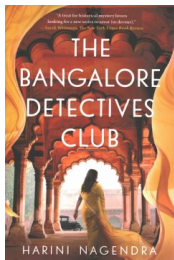


Pony Confidential

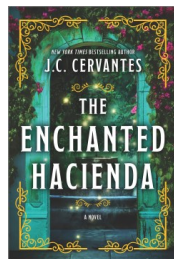

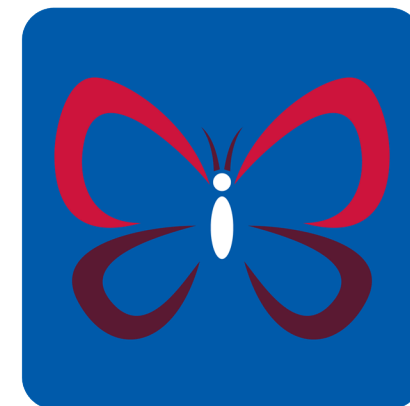

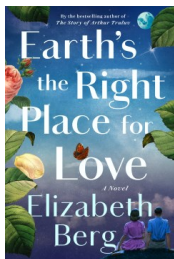

Arthur becomes friends with the hottest girl in his class even though she has a crush on his older brother and must come to terms with grief and how to go on when a sudden tragedy changes his world.

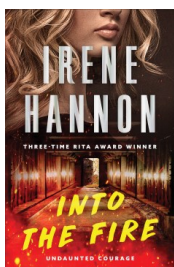


Under the Cover of Mercy

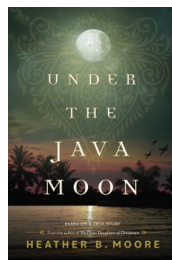


The Paris Daughter

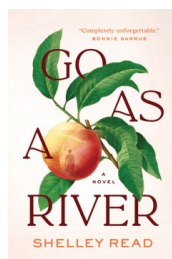


Under the Java Moon

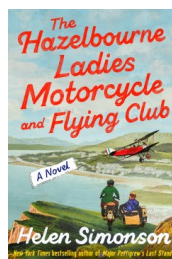


Go as a River

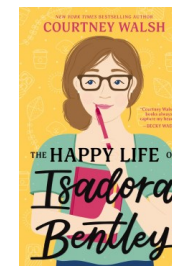


The Hazelbourne Ladies Motorcycle and Flying Club

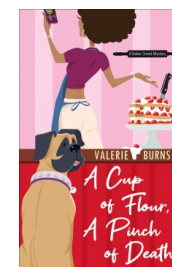
The Happy Life of Isadora Bentley

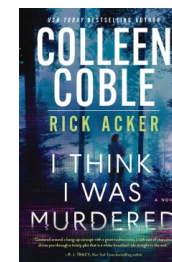


A Cup of Flour, a Pinch of Death

Maddy Montgomery becomes a murder suspect after the woman who stole her fiancé is found dead inside her successful shop, Baby Cakes Bakery.

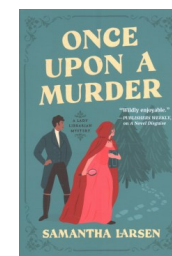


I Think I Was Murdered
