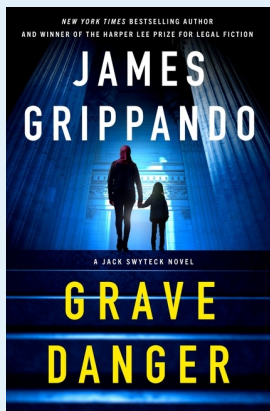

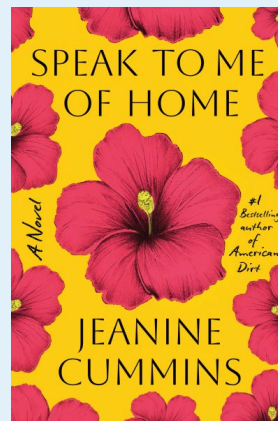

by James Grippando

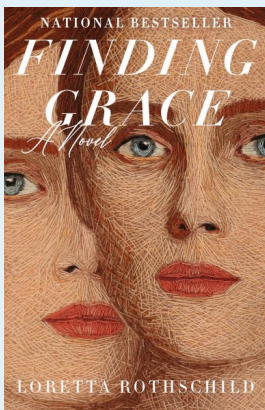
