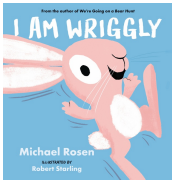

Hijinks ensue when roommates Bat, Cat, and Rat take a trip to the beach.

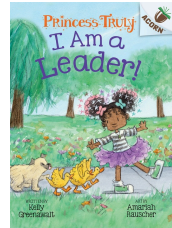


### **The Baby Who Stayed Awake Forever**

At bedtime, a family tries in vain to get their energetic baby to fall asleep.

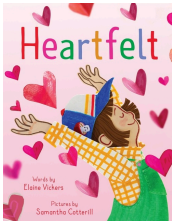


### **I Am a Leader!**

Across three stories, Princess Truly takes the lead by being class leader, helping her pup, Sir Noodle, dance in a talent show, and helping lost ducklings find their mom.

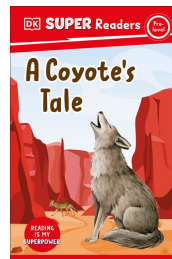


### **Heartfelt**

Come to the American Southwest to learn how coyotes howl and hunt in their desert home.

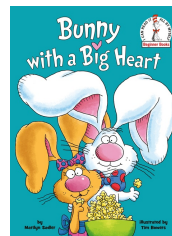


### **Snap! Crunch! Munch?**

Every morning, young Tabitha greets the sun, loving how it brings everyone joy, but one day the sun is missing, so she makes up her mind to find it.

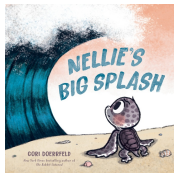


## Dream Big

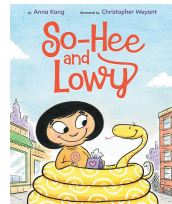


## Let's Be Bees

A father and child become buzzing bees, rustling trees, and more in this delightful make-believe romp.

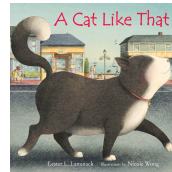


## So-Hee and Lowy

So-Hee is lonely. When she meets a snake named Lowy her life starts to change in unexpected ways.

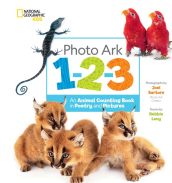


## A Cat Like That

After days of no buffalo sightings, Rose defies instructions to stay at camp, dons her father's wolf skin, and successfully tracks a herd of buffalo.

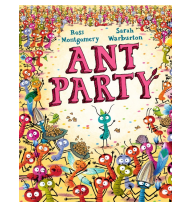


## Who Ate Steve?
