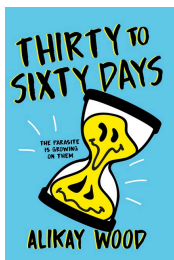


How To Survive a Slasher

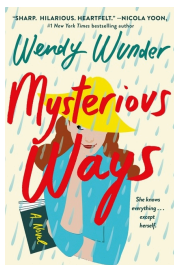


Thirty to Sixty Days

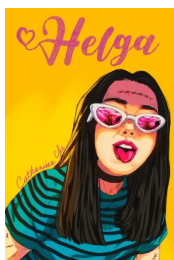


Mysterious Ways

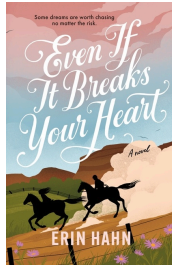


Breakup From Hell

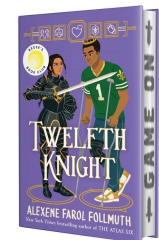


Beach Cute

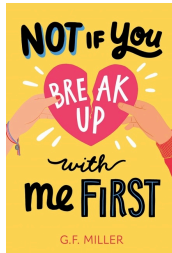
Twelfth Knight
