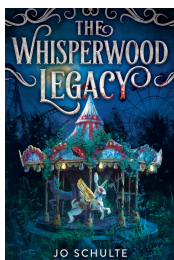




Salvación

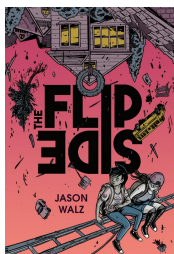

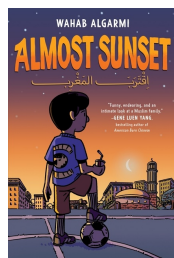


The Last Dragon on Mars

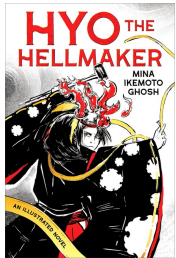


Wish Upon a K-Star
