

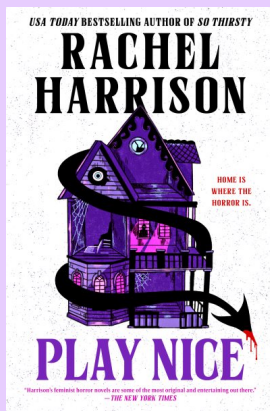

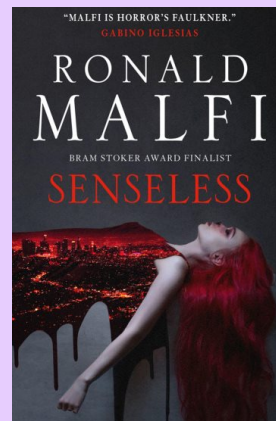

by Rachel Harrison

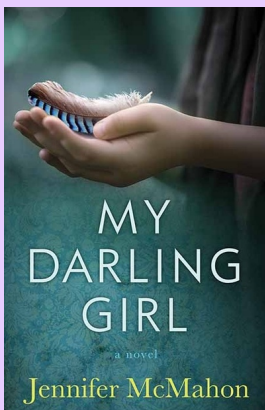

by Ronald Malfi

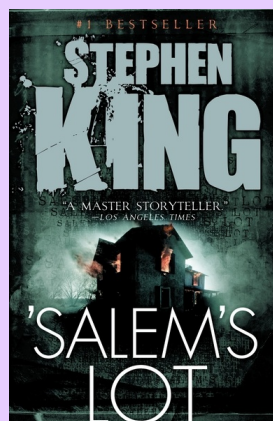
