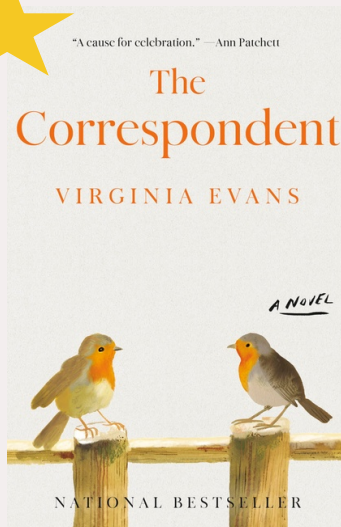




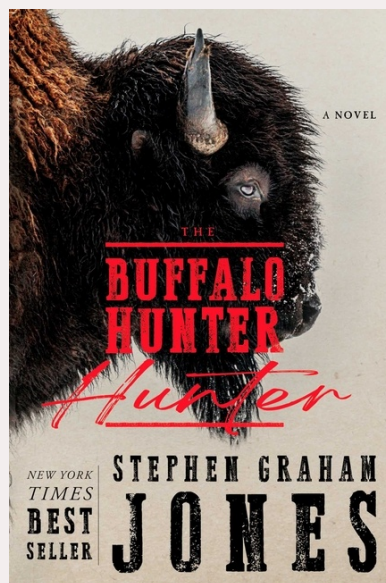
Ellen's PICKS

For books read in October 2025

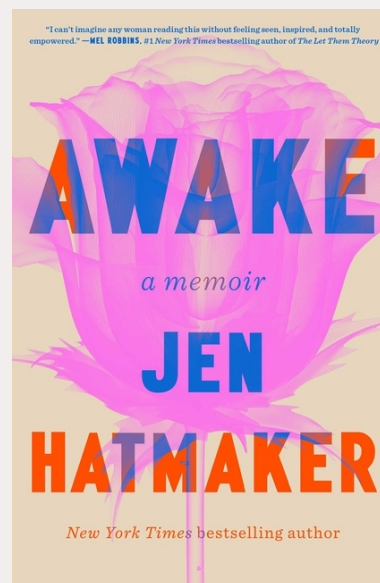
