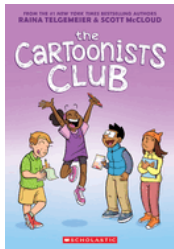

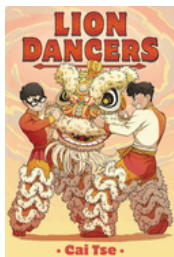


Read the pictures in these full-length stories that combine text and graphics.

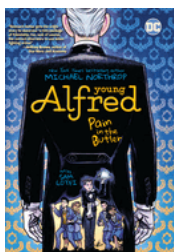
Lion Dancers

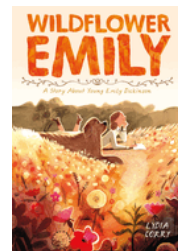
Young Alfred

The origin story of Batman's butler, Alfred Pennyworth, featuring special appearances by Batman, the Joker, and Harley Quinn.



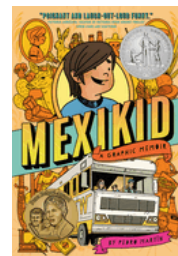
Puzzled

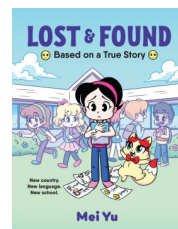
Wildflower Emily

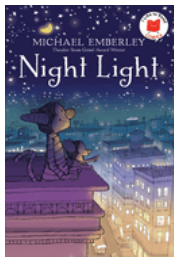
Things in the Basement

During a blackout, a parent gathers stars to comfort their child, then returns them to the sky, and together they sleep under the stars outside.

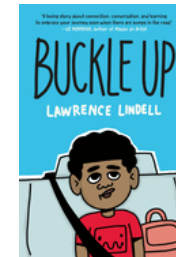


Cloud Puppy

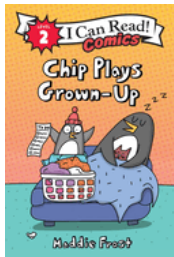


Buckle Up
