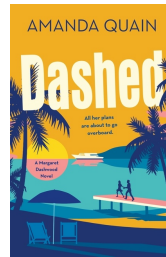


What's Eating Jackie Oh?

A Korean American teen tries to balance her dream to become a chef with the cultural expectations of her family when she enters the world of a TV cooking show.

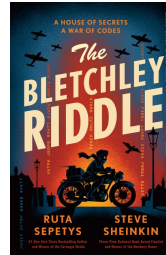

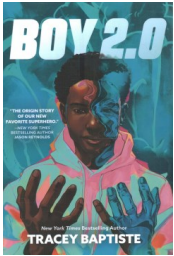


The Singular Life of Aria Patel

Coal, suddenly able to turn invisible, searches for answers about who and what he is, but the truth is far stranger and more dangerous than he ever could have imagined.

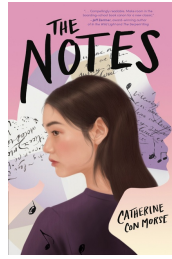


What Comes After

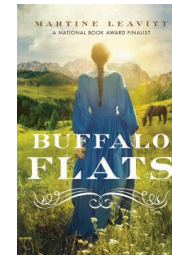


Trajectory
