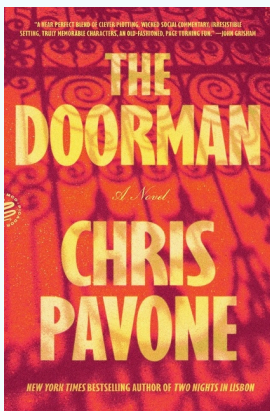

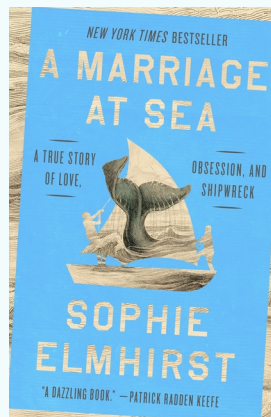
**The Doorman**
