




by C. J. Box



by Bailey Seybolt



by Susie Dent



by Peter Swanson



by Walter Mosley



by Richard Osman






## Presumed Guilty





by Wally Lamb



by Anne Hillerman



by John Grisham



by Allen Eskens



by Patti Callahan Henry


