




by Gillian McAllister



by Dean Koontz



by Brad Taylor



by Julie Clark






The Missing Half




A young woman, Jet Mason, has one week to solve her own impending murder after a violent attack on Halloween night leaves her with a fatal injury.

by Katy Hays


From the bestselling author of *The Cloisters*, comes a slow-burn psychological drama about an opulent family that unravels when a decades-old crime resurfaces.

by Karen Thompson Walker



by John Grisham




