



The Man Made of Smoke


The Locked Ward





A retired serial killer receives a knock on the door. The uninvited guest threatens to blow up her quiet life if she doesn't start killing again. What's a gal to do?




Last Seen



After killing an intruder in self-defense, a mother must unravel a terrifying mystery filled with twists and turns.




The Oligarch's Daughter




Leverage


