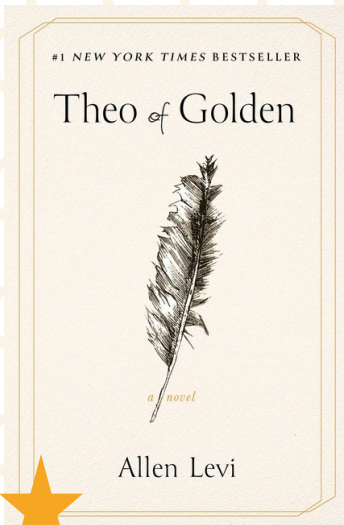


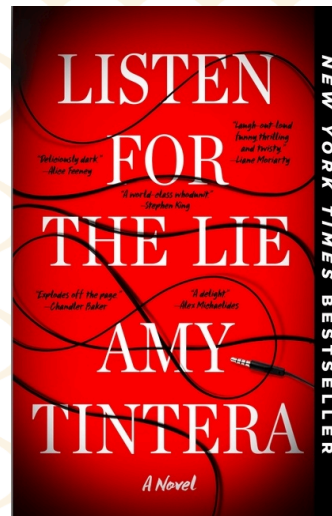

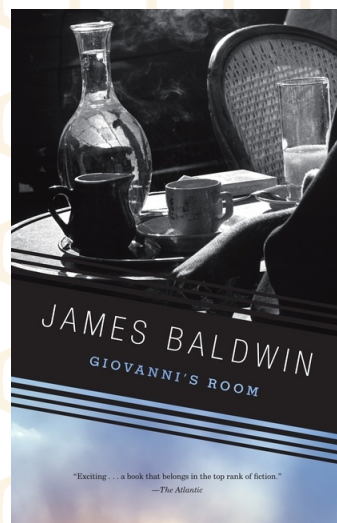
Slow start but about halfway through I really got into it. It was such a quiet book. A beautiful story about kindness, friendship and the importance of beauty and art in our world.

FIVE STARS!!

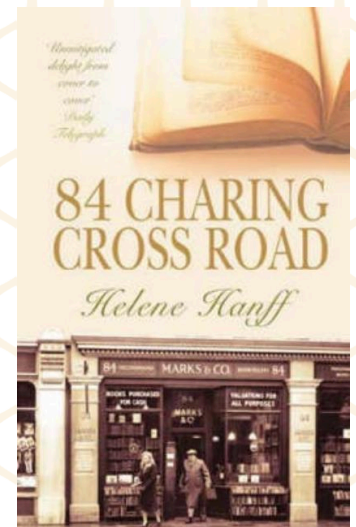
