



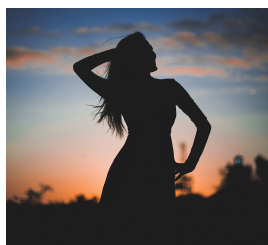

Come and join yarn crafters who like to knit, crochet, embroider, and such. All experience levels welcome.



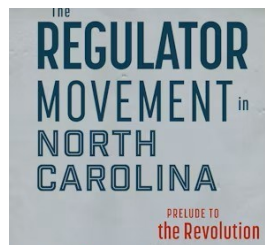
Tai Chi

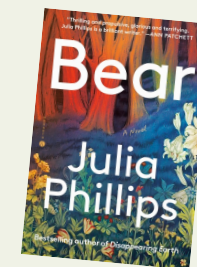
