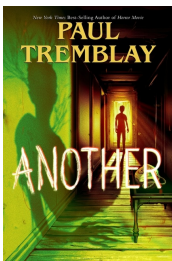


Hide and Shriek

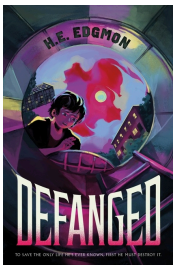
The Tale of the Vanishing Circus

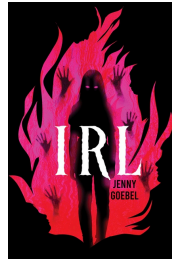
