A class for those with basic crochet skills. We'll work on a project, learn new stitches, and share ideas. Bring your own supplies.

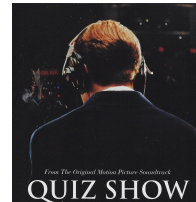


America250 Art Contest
