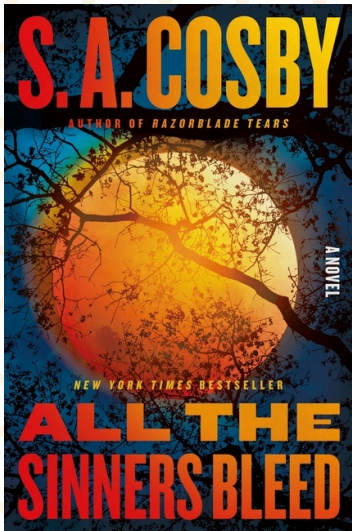


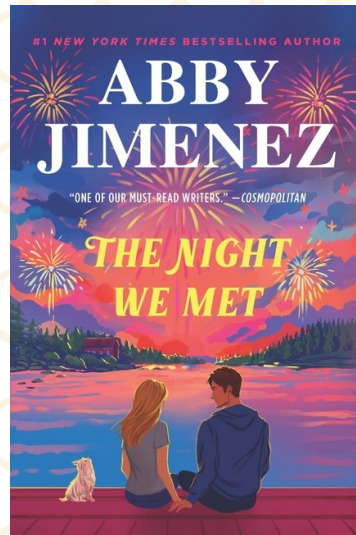


Ellen's PICKS
