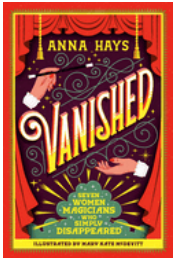


The Undead Fox of Deadwood Forest

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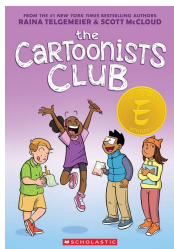


The Bug Bandits

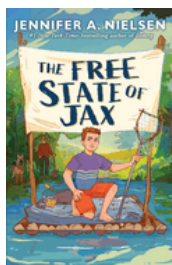


Good Boy

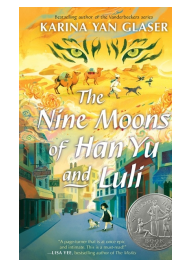


The Danger Files

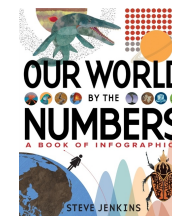


Octopus Moon
