- The Equinox gives us 12 hours of day and night because Earth's orbital axis is neither pointing towards or away from the Sun!
- "Equinox" gets its name from the Latin roots "Aequus" (Equal) and "Nox" (Night)!
- Some Ancient Greek calendars placed the beginning of the year at the autumnal equinox!
