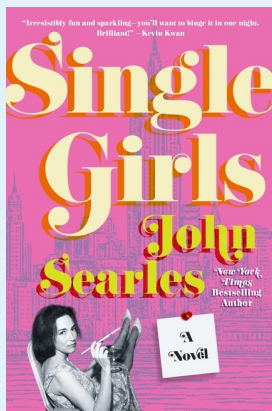

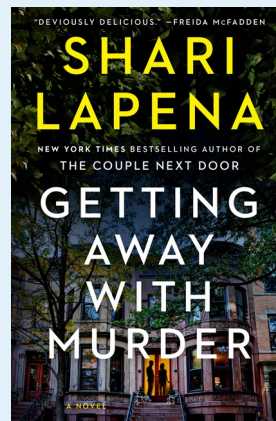

by John Searles

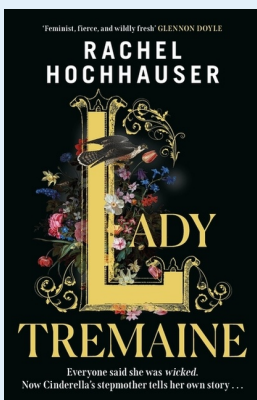
